#### Message from the Chairman

This exhibition was established to provide more opportunities for PJ and PT printmakers to exhibit, and 24 entrants from seven countries submitted 298 prints. There were 105 acceptances (35%) and 16 medals awarded.

The judging was scheduled for March 28 and most of the entries had already arrived when a lockdown was imposed on March 12 due to the pandemic. Because the jury was unable to meet, we were able to include lost packages that arrived late, and the judging was rescheduled

for August. But that also had to be canceled because meetings were still not possible, so the prints were organized and shipped to the individual judges with instructions for scoring.

To minimize the need for rejudging, the prints were ranked within each section by each judge and, to determine the awards, tie scores were broken by consensus. It was a slow process, but when the results were finalized, reports were sent, medals were packaged and mailed, and the PSA paperwork could begin. After the four EDAS reports were typed and filed, the next task was this catalog, but dates for the display of the accepted prints cannot be predicted right now.

This exhibition will not be held again because an application for recognition must be submitted at least five months in advance, and at this time there is no way to know the probability of judges being able to meet next spring. While digital exhibitions can depend on remote scoring, print juries need to view the actual prints, so the future of print exhibitions remains unknown.
